

## **2017 Tuition and Fees**

### **Intro to Montessori & 3-6 Overview**

(one week, offered as Montessori introduction to non-teaching or specialty staff and *required for those elementary teachers without 3-6 credentials*)

- Application fee (non-refundable): \$50 (only required for those not taking full training program)
- Tuition: \$775 (due in full by June 1, 2017)
- Discount: \$50 (if paid by May 1, 2017)

### **Elementary I (6-9) Certification Program**

(9 weeks of training over two summers, two weekend seminars, albums & materials, plus 3 on-site consultation visits)

- Application fee (non-refundable): \$150
- Tuition: \$7,725 (due in full by June 1, 2017, or can be paid in two-parts — 60% before for first summer, 40% before second summer, plus a 5% surcharge on total)
- Discount: \$350 (if paid by May 1, 2017)
- Accreditation fees: \$395

### **Elementary I-II (6-12) Certification Program in Three Summers**

(Combines 6-9 schedule for first two summers and 9-12 schedule for third summer; includes same four weekend seminars, albums & materials, plus 3 on-site consultation visits)

- Application fee (non-refundable): \$150
- Tuition: \$11,995 (due in full by June 1, 2017, but can be broken down to three payments of 40%—30%—30% each summer, with a 5% surcharge on total)
- Discount: \$500 (if paid by May 1, 2017)
- Accreditation fees: \$395

### **Elementary II (9-12 for holders of an AMS Elementary I credential) Certification Program**

(three and a half weeks of summer training, two weekend seminars, albums & materials — no consultation visits are required or included if already 6-9 certified)

- Application fee (non-refundable): \$150
- Tuition: \$4,375 for continuing METTC & CMTE/NY students; \$4,890 for certified transfer students from other programs (due in full by June 1, 2017)
- Discount: \$250 (if paid by May 1, 2017)
- Accreditation fees: \$395
